



Tower Scramble

Tuesday, November 4, 2025 - 0900 Hours

Separate assault and sniper elements engage targets from different vantage points on and around the 50-foot tower. Accuracy and speed will be tested as team members ascend the stairs and rappel down the side.

QRF / Hostage Rescue

Tuesday, November 4, 2025 - 1100 Hours

The event is simulating a team in the area of an unknown critical event. The team is unprepared and not operationally ready. The team will have to don their equipment and respond to the area of the critical incident to conduct a hostage rescue.

Pricher Scramble

Wednesday, November 5, 2025 - 0900 Hours

This event requires each team to work together to traverse various obstacles and arrive at shooting positions from which each team member will engage his/her targets.



Officer Rescue

Thursday, November 6, 2025 - 0900 Hours

AThe Officer Rescue requires the assault team to traverse a pre-positioned/pre-stretched line, engage targets, and rescue a downed officer.

Obstacle Course

Friday, November 7, 2025 - 0800 Hours

The one-and-only SWAT Round-Up Obstacle Course is revered for its physically daunting challenges. Teamwork, strength, and stamina are necessary to conquer the obstacles and cross the finish line as a team.

Sam was born and raised in North Kissimmee and attended Osceola High School. After graduating, Sam enlisted in the U.S. Army where he honorably served the United States in Iraq.

Upon his return home, Sam still felt a strong urge to serve, so he became a police officer at the Kissimmee (FL) Police Department, where he proudly served for 10 years until his untimely death.

Sam always possessed an infectious smile that he shared with everyone he personally contacted. Behind that smile was a hard-working Police Sergeant who believed the best existed in his family, friends, coworkers and members of the community. For those of you fortunate to meet or know Sam, his smile was infectious!

Sam was a highly valued and seasoned member of the Kissimmee Police Department, working in Uniform Patrol, the DUI unit, Traffic Enforcement Unit and Criminal Investigations. He was also a skilled and tenured member of the Kissimmee PD SWAT team as a Sniper. He always dedicated himself to building up his fellow team members. Sam had many hobbies in life: cars, racing, music and lifting all the weight in the gym during one of

On Monday, March 20, 2023, Mike was training in the gym, off duty, when he experienced a headache that medical professionals diagnosed as a serious brain injury. He was rushed to the hospital and on Sunday, March 26, 2023, Deputy Milmerstadt was laid to rest after being kept alive on life support to provide his organs to eight other individuals in one final act before his death.

Milmerstadt, who is the father of three young boys, worked for OCSO for seven years. He was a member of the Community Oriented Policing Squad (COPS) and the agency's Special Weapons and Tactics (SWAT) team.

Mike believed in living a fulfilled life and pushing past his limits every day. One of his passions was working and CrossFit, and he would push himself to the max to

complete the most challenging workouts. He lived by the motto, "Earn the Day," which meant that he never took a day for granted and always made the most of every opportunity. Mike was an inspiration to those around him, always encouraging others to push themselves and reach their full potential.
