

NVG Familiarization | Class, Practicals, Range

October 28 – 29, 2025 | Day 1: 8a – 5p, Day 2: 3p – 12a

Day 1 location: Meet at the 3-story Tactical Training Facility just west of the north range building.

This 2-day course of NVG familiarization accelerates students through a quick classroom portion covering topics on theory, principals, light, inner workings of night vision followed by a hands-on exploration of topics covered in class. On day 2 students employ firearms in a reduced visibility (live) range environment conducting challenging drills.

## Student Responsibilities and Requirements:

- o An understanding of safe weapons manipulation in low, zero visibility
- Your duty / call-out gear
- Body armor
- Helmet (with shroud / mounting plate)
- NVG mount
- NVGs (that are helmet mountable)
- o Pistol and rifle mounted optics that are zeroed
- o Infrared rifle-mounted and zeroed LASER
- o NLTA: 100 pistol, 200 rifle (UTM and or FX with appropriate pistol and bolt carrier group)
- Handheld flashlight
- Weapon mounted flashlight for both pistol and rifle
- Batteries for all equipment
- o Water, food (no time to go anywhere), appropriate clothing, headlamp
- o 3 mags for each weapon that can be secured
- o Live ammo: 250 pistol, 750 rifle
- o <u>Clear</u> eye protection and <u>electronic</u> hearing protection
- Note taking material and a willingness to learn
