U.S. TEAM REQUIREMENTS AND FEES

Each “competing team” member must be a sworn law enforcement, military or corrections officer, and a member of the registered agency’s response team (SWAT, ERT, SRT, etc.).

- “Competing team” refers to all team members who are registered and eligible to compete in the team events during the week. **Five (5) competitors are required for the Pricher Scramble mandatory team event; six (6) competitors are required for the Tower Scramble, Officer Rescue, Hostage Rescue and Obstacle Course mandatory team events. Up to eight (8) team members may register.** Those eight (8) team members may alternate on any given event. If any team does not have the required number of team members to compete in any given team event, that team will be disqualified.

The **team registration fee of \$1,100 includes** ALL registered members of the team (up to 8). This fee includes a Florida SWAT Association basic membership (valued at \$25 each) for each of the eight competing team members for one year; Round-Up training classes on Monday; participation in the individual and team competition events; entry into the FSA Meeting/Vendor Appreciation Night (Wednesday night); and entry into the Awards Ceremony/Dinner (Friday night).

U.S. INDIVIDUAL REGISTRATION REQUIREMENTS AND FEES

Any additional sworn personnel who accompany a registered team, or a sworn law enforcement officer from a law enforcement agency, may register to attend the training classes and participate in the individual events (non-team events). There is a **\$250 registration fee** for each individual that includes training classes on Monday; participation in the individual competition events; entry into the FSA Meeting/Vendor Appreciation Night (Wednesday night); and entry into the Awards Ceremony/Dinner (Friday night). These additional personnel and individual registrants will be considered “non-competing attendees” and cannot compete in the team competition events or be swapped out for registered team members.



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TRAINING CLASS REGISTRATION

All members of a competing team (up to 8) are required to attend at least one (1) of the training classes scheduled on Monday, November 3, 2025. Training class information will be sent to the team leaders once team and individual registration opens.

Training class selections can be modified until Friday, October 17, 2025. No changes will be allowed after October 17, 2025, unless there is a revision to the team roster or other extenuating circumstances. Each member's attendance at his/her class will be verified on the day of the class. You will be required to sign the class sign-in sheet in order to get credit for participating in the class. **If a competing team member fails to show up for one (1) required training class, a one-minute (60 second) penalty will be assessed against his/her team as described below.**

Each team is expected to bring all items needed for training and competition (i.e., weapons, ammo, gas masks, duty belts, protective eye and ear equipment, gloves, protective vests, etc.). It will be the responsibility of the team leader to acquire or borrow any needed equipment from another team or from a vendor.

TEAM PENALTIES

If a competing team member does not attend one (1) required training class, a penalty will be charged against the respective team. The penalty will be charged as one-minute (60 seconds) and will be added to the team's final time for Event #1. This one-minute (60 second) penalty will be assessed for each competing team member who fails to attend at least one (1) class.

Example: If two competing team members do not attend one class each, a two-minute (120 second) penalty will be added to the team's final time in Event #1.

PRACTICE / TRAINING TIME

AVAILABLE ONLY BY APPOINTMENT BEFORE OCTOBER 20, 2025

Appointments for practice or training time on the Orange County Sheriff's Office Range will be made on a first-come, first-served basis. **WALK-ONS ARE NOT PERMITTED.** Please contact the OCSO Range at (407) 254-6630 to schedule an appointment. **Please remember, practice/training time will only be permitted by appointment; no walk-ons.**

The OCSO Range will be closed Monday, October 20, 2025, through Friday, October 31, 2025, to prepare for the competition.



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AMMUNITION REQUIREMENTS

An Equipment List will be sent with the team competition event descriptions to all team leaders once you register for SWAT Round-Up.

UNIFORM DRESS CODE FOR COMPETITORS

ALL registered team competitors must wear mission ready uniforms, which are specified as the uniform team members wear for callouts. This includes BDU-style long pants, BDU-style or other long sleeve shirts and tactical footwear (boots with high tops). **Any participant who reports to the ready line not wearing the appropriate mission ready uniform will be assessed a fifteen (15) second procedural penalty per participant, per event.**

If a team is sponsored by a specific company and wishes to display company logos, graphics, etc., on their uniform to advertise for that vendor, there may be no profanity or vulgar depictions. The SRI Committee requests that the graphics be submitted to SRI Director Mike Perales @ sridirector@floridaswat.org for approval.

During the team Obstacle Course event on Friday, participants may wear athletic clothing such as shorts, running shoes, t-shirts, etc.

SONG / MUSIC SELECTION FOR OBSTACLE COURSE

Teams can select songs / music that will be played while the team is running the Obstacle Course on Friday.

THE TEAM LEADER OR TEAM REPRESENTATIVE WILL NEED TO STOP BY THE FSA BOOTH (#10N) STARTING TUESDAY (11/4/25) THROUGH THURSDAY (11/6/25) AND SPEAK WITH KENDRA GOEBEL SO SHE CAN MAKE SURE THE SONG CAN BE DOWNLOADED AND IS READY FOR FRIDAY. THE SONGS / MUSIC WILL NEED TO BE SELECTED BY THURSDAY, NOVEMBER 6, 2025, BY 3:00 P.M.

PLEASE SELECT SONGS / MUSIC WITH NO PROFANITY AND/OR EXPLICIT LYRICS AS THERE WILL BE CHILDREN AND FAMILIES WATCHING THE O' COURSE EVENT. Any songs/music that is deemed inappropriate by the SRI Committee will not be played.

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REGISTRATION DESK CHECK-IN

ALL TEAMS LEADERS and REGISTERED INDIVIDUAL ATTENDEES must report to the Registration Desk on Sunday, November 2, 2025, which will be located at the Orlando Airport Marriott Lakeside, Capri Meeting Room. This mandatory check-in will be open from 8:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m. Any unpaid team/individual registration fees must be paid at this time.

MANDATORY - ALL ATTENDEES, REGARDLESS OF PARTICIPATION, ARE REQUIRED TO PROVIDE A COPY OF THEIR AGENCY ISSUED PHOTO IDENTIFICATION OR MILITARY IDENTIFICATION AT THE TIME OF TEAM CHECK-IN ON SUNDAY, NOVEMBER 2, 2025. PLEASE ATTACH A COPY OF YOUR IDENTIFICATION TO YOUR ORIGINAL SIGNED WAIVER FORM AND TURN IT IN AT REGISTRATION.

WAIVER OF LIABILITY FORMS - MANDATORY

The Agency Head Waiver of Liability form must be completed and signed by your agency head or his/her designee. The Participant/Competitor/Attendee Waiver of Liability form can be copied for each participant/competitor to sign. All agency individual attendees must also complete and sign this form even if they do not participate in the competition. All original forms must be turned in at the Registration Desk on Sunday, November 2, 2025. The waiver forms will be emailed to the team leader once the team registers to participate in SWAT Round-Up.

SRI MERCHANDISE

SWAT Round-Up merchandise will be sold during team/individual registration in the Capri Meeting Room, and before and after the Opening Ceremonies in the Grand Ballroom Foyer on Sunday, November 2, 2025. Quantities and sizes are limited so make sure you get your merchandise before it sells out!

IMPORTANT CHANGE - WEAPONS SIGHT-IN

Teams/individuals wanting to sight in their weapons at the OCSO Range will need to make an appointment with International Team Liaison Raul Rivas - call/text him @ (321) 624-3308 or email him @ rrivas6715@gmail.com. Each team member will be limited to ten (10) rounds. The below dates and times are when appointment times are available:

- Sunday – November 2, 2025 - 0800 to 12 Noon

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PROTEST / GRIEVANCE PROCEDURES

All protests/grievances must be submitted, in writing, within sixty (60) minutes of the team's completion of the event. Protests/grievances must be presented to the Chief Judge by the team's designated team leader or team spokesperson. No other team member may be present. The Chief Judge, along with the appropriate Assistant Chief Judge, will review the grievance. A final decision will not be made until after the entire event has concluded. The judge's decisions are final. Grievances will not be accepted for issues related to weather conditions. If a grievance is found to be valid and with merit, the team will be permitted a second grievance during the competition. However, if a grievance is found to be without merit, the team will not have any other opportunities to present additional grievances during any additional competition events.

VISITORS, CHILDREN AND GUESTS

This event IS NOT open to the public. However, family members or other law enforcement personnel are welcome to visit the facilities during competition events as spectators. All visitors are required to check in at the registration desk located at the OCSO Range, sign appropriate waiver forms and obtain a guest badge, which must be displayed at all times while on the range property. **Children must be accompanied by an adult at all times at the range facility. PLEASE DO NOT ALLOW CHILDREN TO PLAY ON THE BERMS, THE OBSTACLE COURSE, GOLF CARTS OR ANY OTHER EQUIPMENT AT THE RANGE FACILITY.**

DRESS CODE AT RANGE: Visitors/guests must be dressed in a manner consistent for outdoor and shooting range activities. Shirts and blouses should cover the shoulders and upper body. Pants are highly recommended to protect bare skin during live fire competitions. Flat soled and/or athletic type shoes are recommended due to the uneven and rough terrain at the Range. Large purses, bags and backpacks are subject to inspection by the on-duty deputies posted at registration.

The Range is a NO SMOKING / NO TOBACCO PRODUCTS facility (INCLUDING VAPING) and will continue to remain so during SWAT Round-Up. ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ARE ALSO NOT PERMITTED ON ANY PORTION OF THE RANGE PROPERTY AT ANY TIME!

OPENING CEREMONIES

The Opening Ceremonies will be held on Sunday, November 2, 2025, at 1:00 p.m., at the Orlando Airport Marriott Lakeside, Grand Ballroom. **ATTENDANCE AT THE OPENING CEREMONIES IS MANDATORY FOR ALL COMPETING TEAM MEMBERS.**



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AWARDS CEREMONY / DINNER

The Awards Ceremony/Dinner will be held on Friday, November 7, 2025, at the Orlando Airport Marriott Lakeside, Grand Ballroom. Cash bar starts at 1800 hours, followed by dinner at 1900 hours. Reserved seating will be provided for the overall top three (3) teams; other seating is on a first-come, first-served basis. **Tickets for additional guests can be purchased, payable in cash or credit card, no later than Wednesday, November 5, 2025, at 5:00 p.m., at the FSA vendor booth (10N).**
