An OIS resolved the incident. This debrief will assess what went well, what could be improved, and discuss considerations for future incidents

### **DEVELOPING THE TACTICAL LEADER'S BRAIN:**

### **OPTIMIZING COGNITIVE DECISION-MAKING FOR SUCCESS**

**Jeff Selleg, NTOA - Committee Chair of NTOA's Tactical Leadership Committee**

This seminar discusses maximizing the Warriors' cerebral processes critical to success in a team environment and preparing them for peak performance during the fight. Throughout history, influential tactical leaders have honed their bodies to peak performance by focused exercise and constantly challenging their bodies to improve. No one argues the need for sustained, disciplined and concentrated effort at functional fitness combined with repetitive skill training to drive the utmost performance for SWAT officers. This seminar interweaves two key cognitive elements that tactical officers must develop to perform at their topmost levels. The presenter will briefly overview Emotional Intelligence and its necessity in the tactical response realm. Then, discuss how the EQi2 instrument measures emotional intelligence and provide specific techniques to improve each subcomponent.

The seminar then overviews the NTOA's exciting new partnership with Posit Science to bring cutting-edge individual cognitive development exercises to public safety. BrainHQ has provided elite-level military special forces and professional athletes a distinct advantage over their adversaries for over a decade. NFL quarterbacks, MLB hitters, and SOCOM's select soldiers, marines, sailors, and airmen utilize these exercises to build resiliency and performance across all levels of their cognition. This overview describes the partnership and demonstrates each exercise in the NTOA's focused programming. This segment will conclude with an overview of research and medical studies on cognitive development training and improving law enforcement performance.

Focus will be on theory and principals of NVGs, application of visible and infrared energy systems, photonic barrier defeat methods, passive and active aiming and how all of these tools are combined to ensure mission success and much more. NVGs and associated systems are not required to take this course, but should be brought to the course if you have them.

### **LAW ENFORCEMENT PROTECTIVE SECURITY OPERATIONS**

**Tom Wynn, (DHS HSI (Retired) / Roger "Doc" Penna / Jeff Jay, Wynn Solutions Group, Inc. / Karla Stowe, Crisp Co SO**

The Law Enforcement Protective Security Operations (LEPSO) seminar will provide students with basic principles and concepts related to protective operation missions. Law enforcement officers are often tasked with this unique mission with little or no formal training. The 4-hour seminar will serve as an introduction and will highlight the 5-day comprehensive Law Enforcement Protective Security Operations Training Program (LEPSOTP) based largely on the established and tested methodologies used by the U.S. Secret Service and the U.S. Department of State's Bureau of Diplomatic Security Service. Subjects covered include: Introduction to Protective Operations for LE; Protective Security Formations; Motorcade Operations (Arrival/Departure); Attack on Principal Drills; Threat Identification and Mitigation; and Protective Agent Course of Fire.

**STUDENT REQUIREMENTS: JACKET – BDU TYPE SHIRT OR BLOUSE IS SUFFICIENT; HANDGUN; (100 ROUNDS OF FRANGIBLE AMMO); BELT TYPE HOLSTER (EITHER INSIDE THE WAISTBAND (IWB) OR OUTSIDE THE WAISTBAND HOLSTER (OWB) – CONCEALED); EYE AND EAR PROTECTION; AND WATER TO STAY HYDRATED. WEAPONS AND PROTECTIVE SECURITY EQUIPMENT MUST BE CONCEALED DURING THIS TRAINING COURSE. NO THIGH HOLSTERS!**

### **NOVUM STRATEGIC TACTICAL RIFLE FUNDAMENTALS**

### **OFFICER RESCUE**

***William J. (BJ) Hall / John Mikula / Peter Roehrig / Brian Erb, Florida SWAT Association***

This course will focus on the rescue of a downed officer/civilian and treatment. Students will be trained in advanced rescue techniques that can be used to perform a rescue in a high-risk environment and the treatment to increase the chance of survival of the downed officer/civilian. Students will be trained in an open field rescue, rescue from a vehicle, and rescue from a structure. During the training, we will teach the students how to extract an injured person from the point of injury using drag and carries, as well as other extraction devices (skeds, litters, etc.).

***STUDENT REQUIREMENTS: TACTICAL UNIFORM, VEST, HELMET, GLOVES AND EYE PROTECTION. NO WEAPONS OR AMMO!***

### **QUICK REACTION FORCE (QRF) TRAINING**

QRF training will involve all live fire courses, which include deploying from vehicles, working through crowds and all aspects that a QRF team could face. These will be two to four-person teams that flow together in a common way to stop the threat. There will be a lot of moving targets and challenges that personnel would experience in a mass shooting situation. A very fluid and active course.

***STUDENT REQUIREMENTS: STUDENTS ARE EXPECTED TO BRING ALL WEAPONS SYSTEMS ISSUED TO THEM BY THEIR AGENCY WITH SUFFICIENT AMMUNITION TO CONDUCT FIREARMS TRAINING (FULL KIT – HANDGUNS (100 ROUNDS) – LONG GUNS (200 ROUNDS); EYE PROTECTION; EAR PROTECTION; HELMET; ENTRY/HEAVY VEST; AND WATER TO STAY HYDRATED.***

OPTIONAL EQUIPMENT TO ALSO BRING: ANOTHER RDS EQUIPPED PISTOL; LONG SLEEVE SHIRT; HAT; WATER BOTTLE; SNACKS; AND SUNSCREEN.**

### **SPECIAL OPERATIONS COMBATIVES PROGRAM (SOCP)**

***John Kirkland, Orange County SO / Monty Massey***

SOCP (Special Operations Combatives Program) is a realism based, task-specific system designed to bridge the gap between foundational fight skills and the unique needs of the modern day assaulter in the CQB environment. SOCP is the designated combatives program for all U.S. Army Special Operations Forces. ERB Codes: (SOCP I: BRT), (SOCP II: FBR) SOCP is now the standard program for fighting in kit and bridging the gap between CQB and combatives. SOCP is currently being implemented at Special Forces Units 1st, 3rd, 5<sup>th</sup>, 7th, 10th, SWCS; Special Forces Advanced Skills Battalion; 75 Ranger Regiment; Marine RECON; MARSOC; Air Force SERE; Para Rescue and is spreading fast to other Special Units, FBI, ATF, Border Patrol and other Federal and State Law Enforcement, including Orange County Sheriff's Office SWAT, as well as Special Contract Units. SOCP Concepts: \*Fighting in Kit with weaponry; \*Weapon transition & retention standing or on ground; \*360 degree ambush attacks into and over objects; \*Fighting multiple assailants solo or as a team; \*Compliant and non-compliant cuffing and vehicle extractions; \*Force continuum (lethal/less-than-lethal options); and \*Technique 'linkage'.

**STUDENT REQUIREMENTS: BDU STYLE PANTS; SHIRT OF CHOICE (DRY FIT RECOMMENDED); HELMET (NODS ATTACHMENTS STRIPPED); FLAT SOLE OR WRESTLING SHOES; HOLSTER OR SHOOTER BELT IS OK; NO WEAPONS (TRAINING WEAPONS WILL BE PROVIDED); WATER BOTTLE AND SNACKS.**

### **STACCATO 101**

***Tim Roa, Staccato 2011 / Sponsored by Florida Bullet***

The Staccato 101 course is designed to improve both the operators and department's knowledge, proficiency and handling capabilities of the Staccato 2011 line of pistols through 2011 familiarization, dry fire and live fire drills. Drills conducted are designed to test the operator's accuracy, speed and processing of information (i.e., scored/timed drills while static and moving) within the demands of the SWAT high-risk mission set.

**STUDENT REQUIREMENTS: PROPER RANGE ATTIRE; (300) ROUNDS OF 9MM AMMUNITION; DUTY BELT/RANGE BELT CAPABLE OF HANGING A T-SERIES HOLSTER FROM; PISTOL MAGAZINE POUCHES; SUNSCREEN; HYDRATION SYSTEM; BALLISTIC RATED/APPROVED EYE PROTECTION; AND HEARING PROTECTION (ELECTRONIC RECOMMENDED).**

Staccato will provide (1) Staccato 2011 Pistol, (3) magazines and (1) Blackhawk T-Series L2 Duty Holster per student.

Frangible Ammo will be provided by the instructors.
